The areas of fishing grounds are 376 km² of lagoon and 832 km² off-lagoon (Sambo & Mauree, 1988). The Government prioritizes sustainable artisanal fishery as this sector is vital in providing employment opportunities and protein to some 4000 households in the coastal regions (Sweenarain, 2012). The artisanal fishery catch in 2011 was estimated at 556 tonnes from the lagoon and 336 tonnes from off-lagoon (a total of 892 tonnes).
