The hypothesis that post-concussive symptoms are the result of microstructural brain injury is therefore well recognised. The microstructural injury is thought to consist of traumatic axonal injury, ranging from the more severe diffuse axonal or true shearing injury to milder degrees of axonal damage.

Concussion is recognized as a clinical syndrome of biomechanically induced alteration of brain function, typically affecting memory and orientation, which may involve loss of consciousness (LOC).
