The first Draw-A-Person test was created by Florence Goodenough in 1926 to initially assess intelligence & maturity level in children through a non verbal task: drawing a person. The test was meant to be an alternative to traditional intelligence tests and was a non-verbal, 'nonthreatening' task (ie. no investigator pressures) to evaluate intelligence by scoring the drawings.

## **The “Draw-A-Person” Personality Test | janaenahirney**

The Draw-A-Person test, first conceived by Dr. Florence Goodenough in 1926, is a skill test to measure a child's mental age through a figure drawing task. It estimates the progress of learning visual, cognitive, and motor skills by having the candidate draw a human figure, scoring the drawing for presence and quality of figure features, and comparing the score to children's typical rate of acquisition of figure features.

## **Draw-A-Person test - Pin Eight**

With the Draw a Person test as a base, a number of other tests have developed using figure drawing as a personality assessment tool. For example, the House-Tree-Person test similarly just asks the person to draw those three objects and then inquires about what they have drawn.
