The celestial sphere is tipped relative to the observer in the same way as is the Earth. The extension of the Earth's rotation axis to the sky defines the North and South Celestial Poles (the NCP and SCP), while the extension of the Earth's equatorial plane defines the celestial equator.

The beginning of spring: the time when the Sun crosses the celestial equator and day and night are of equal length, marking the beginning of spring. Autumnal Time when sun crosses equatorial plane: the first day of autumn, when the Sun crosses the plane of the Earth's equator and makes day and night approximately of equal length.
