Introduction. Teaching students to become effective readers is an important goal of the compulsory years of schooling. It involves extending student's vocabularies and knowledge of the world, developing their knowledge of English grammar and their decoding skills, developing their reading fluency and extending their ability to comprehend what they read and view from the literal level to the inferential and critical levels.

The viewing comprehension strategies are organized in a Before-During-After structure, much like traditional reading strategies are. As with reading strategies, there is overlap from one part (e.g., Before Viewing) to another (e.g., After Viewing). That is, some strategies can be used at different times, but we had to place them somewhere.

A cognitive theory to reading comprehension takes into account the reader and the influences that they can have on the development and success of their comprehension. Internal thinking processes are activated, and successful reading comprehension occurs as a result of interactions between the text and the reader (Woolley, 2011; Winch et al., 2014).

Effective reading instruction

Effective reading instruction in Years 1- 3 should balance and blend the teaching of strategies, interactions around literary and non- literary texts, and writing. From the earliest stages, the teaching of reading should focus on skilled reading — a combination of higher-order processes (comprehension) and lower -order processes (decoding).

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
